



Message from the Pastor

<u>SUMMER CONSTRUCTION</u>: Just like Pennsylvania roads, maintenance will be a part of our parishes for the coming months. We ask you to be patient and understanding when there is a roof being replaced or a parking lot being paved.

At St. Teresa we will be replacing the roof on the church in late summer or early fall. The parking lot will be sealed at some point as well. These projects are projected to cost us \$80,000. The roof will be paid for by money from the sale of Our Lady of Fatima and the parking lot will be paid by this year's CSA appeal.

At St. Thomas we have just completed another section of the roof and have two more roofs to go to complete the church: the flat roof over the St. Elizabeth Room and the steeple roof. These were part of a project we started two years ago and will be completed this summer. Also, the parking lots at St. Thomas will be re-surfaced by a company that is doing road work in Corry, Suit-Kote. This will be a three-part process which will entail the parking lot being closed from time to time. The office will remain open during this time, but you may not be able to park in the parking lot. The roofing project will end up costing over \$200,000 taken from a bequest made to the parish and the parking lot will be an additional \$60,000. The parking lot will be paid for out of funds raised over the past two years in the CSA appeal.

We have been addressing some of the physical needs of the two churches over the past two years and we still have several significant projects yet to do at each church. A new roof is needed at St. Teresa Parish center, and the boilers at St. Thomas Church, School, and office need to be replaced.

I thank you for your generosity to our parish in order to make these needed improvements possible. The future of our parish and its churches depends on you. Thank You for being so supportive of what we are doing.

<u>REMINDERS ABOUT PARISH PROCEDURES</u>: We have some procedures in place that help us to make sure things run smoothly. Just a few reminders about some of those:

• FUNERALS: The first point of contact when someone dies is the funeral home. The funeral home will then contact the pastor and the parish office. All the funeral homes have a copy of the funeral planning booklet that we use at St. Thomas and St. Teresa. This booklet is also on our parish website. It has the readings you can choose from and the songs that can be chosen.

• FUNERAL DINNERS: Again, the first point of contact is the funeral home. The funeral home will then contact the office or the pastor to check on availability of the hall, if the funeral dinner is being held at St. Thomas or St. Teresa. The office or the pastor will contact the person in charge of funeral dinners.

• USE OF PARISH BUILDINGS: All organizations need to contact the parish office to arrange for meetings to be held in parish buildings. Those desiring to use the parish buildings for an event need to schedule that with the parish office. We have a variety of groups and rentals using the buildings that need to be coordinated by one person.

• MONEY SECURITY: All fund-raising events need to follow diocesan policy in regard to securing money for your event and for counting and securing the money after the event. Money from fund raising events should never be kept at someone's home, nor should money be sent to someone's home. All money should be turned in to the parish office or placed in envelopes in the collection basket.


2025 Wedding Anniversary Celebration with Bishop Persico
